<sup>\*</sup>River miles are from VA/NC state line. The last 26.5 miles of the South Fork of the New River (from Wagoner access of New River State Park to the border) is designated a National Wild and Scenic River.

LWB (Low Water Bridge) = public and private bridges that may or may not be too low to pass under in varying water stages. The lowest 31 miles of the South Fork of the New River in NC contains only two low water bridges (Fulton Reeves and Kings Creek).
